Alabama corrections officer pleads guilty to sexual assault of two inmates

Department of Prisons corrected the record on April 30, in federal court. The temperature is 54° in the morning, 70° in the afternoon, and 72° at night.

Stargell pleaded guilty on two counts of violating the rights of two women whom he sexually assaulted on multiple occasions inside the prison and one count of making false statements to federal agents from the U.S. Department of Justice Office of the Inspector General.

Stargell worked as an education specialist at the Federal Correctional Institution, Aliceville facility in Aliceville, Alabama.

One of the investigators on the case, James F. Boyersmith, said Stargell's job was, "to help advance inmates' rehabilitation through education," Boyersmith went on to say, "Instead, he abused his power, sexually assaulted two inmates, and lied to try to cover up his actions. This kind of conduct will not be tolerated. Special Agents at the Department of Justice Office of the Inspector General will continue to ensure that anyone who commits these kinds of despicable acts are brought to justice."



During an interview by the investigating agents, officials said Stargell admitted he knew what he was doing was against the law, but carried out the actions anyway.

Stargell will be sentenced on Aug. 27, 2020.
