## **WYOMING:**

Wyoming's policy prohibits receipt and possession of publications that contain nudity or sexually explicit material, defined as follows:

Nudity: A pictorial depiction where male or female genitalia or buttocks, or female breasts including any portion of the areola and/or nipple, are exposed. Publications containing nudity illustrative of medical, educational, or anthropological content may be excluded from this definition.

Sexually Explicit: A pictorial depiction or portrayal of actual or simulated sexual acts including: sexual intercourse; anal or oral sex; masturbation; force or violence in a sexual context, including sexual assault and acts of sadomasochism emphasizing the infliction of pain; behaviors in which one of the participants is a minor or appears to be under the age of 18; bestiality; excretory functions, including but not limited to urination, defecation, or ejaculation; or material which promotes itself based upon such depictions on a routine or regular basis or in individual one (1) time issues. No distinction shall be made between depictions or portrayals of heterosexual or homosexual activity in applying these standards.
