WEST VIRGINIA REGIONAL JAIL AUTHORITY:

The following is the West Virginia Regional Jail's policy:

Magazines, newspapers and periodicals sent to inmates must be mailed directly from the publisher. To be exchanged one for one and not to accumulate to excess. Any such material will not be permitted if it:

- a. contains instructions for the manufacture of explosives, drugs or other unlawful substances;
- b. advocates violence within the jail;
- c. advocates racial, religious or national hatred in a manner as to create a serious danger of violence in the facility; or
- d. encourages sexual behavior which is criminal and/or in violation of facility rules.
