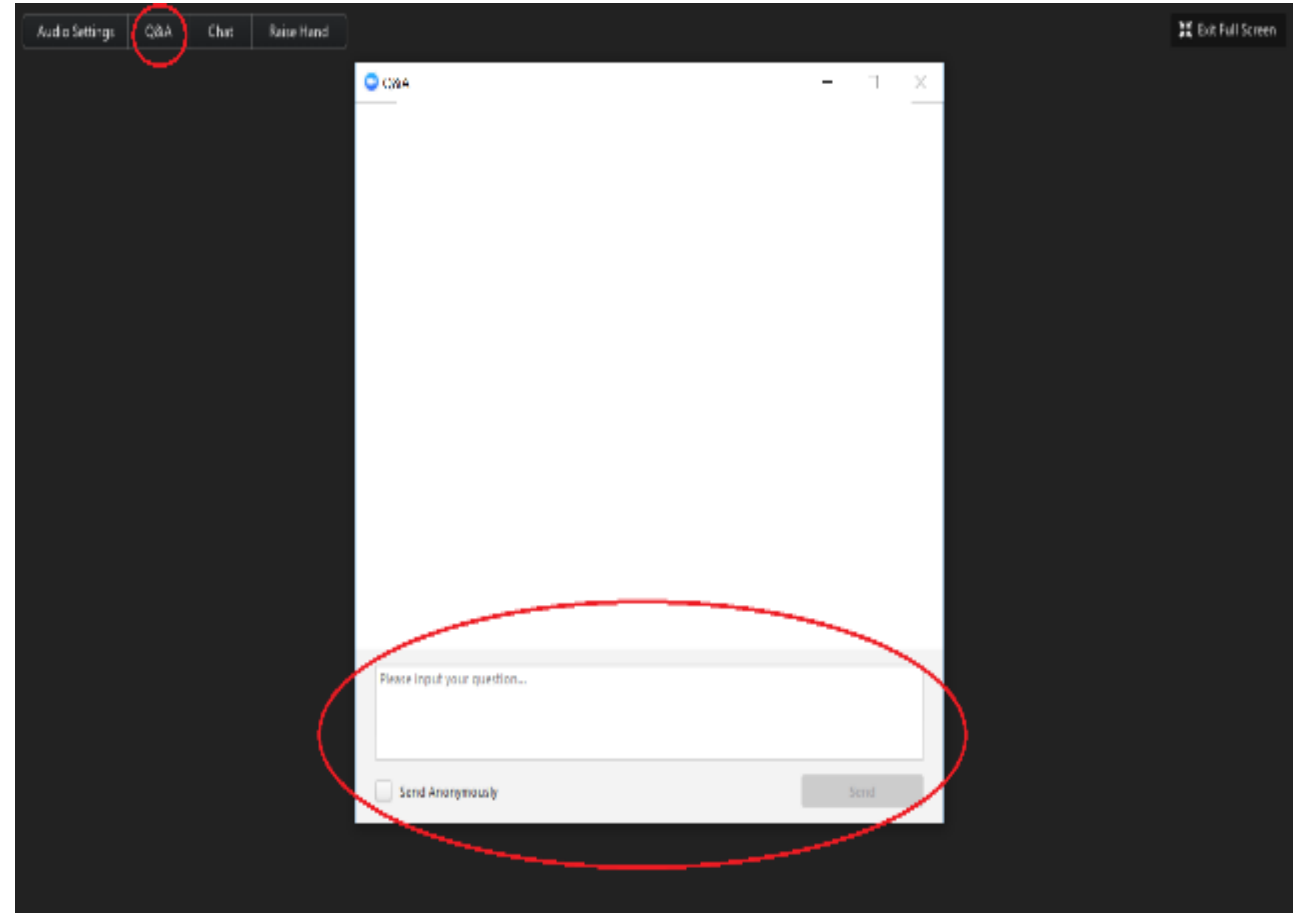

Benefits of the OAS versus Paper Audits

- Minimized Burden
 - Streamlined
 - Organized
 - Efficient
 - Automated
- Increased Security
 - FISMA moderate
 - 2 Factor Authentication
 - Safe storage of sensitive information (including PII and PHI)

Initial Access to the OAS

- Audit Initiation Form – link on PRC website
 - Requestors
 - Agency/Facility
 - Can begin filling out PAQ early
 - Auditor
 - **Auditor must submit Audit Initiation even if the facility/agency has already submitted**
 - Validation process
 - Agency/Facility Users
 - Auditors
- Access granted
 - Automated emails
 - Set up Duo Authentication

Housekeeping

- Browser
 - Updated versions of Firefox, Safari, Chrome
 - IE 10 and above
- Spell and grammar check
 - Engage browser tools
- Autosave
 - System saves ~3 seconds
