Narrative: Criteria for victimization criteria as per VAA:

First Incarceration, Sex Convictions for 69 months, has a documented prior Sex Offense conviction in WA State for RAPE II (85) and sees himself as a target.

Offender, although 6 ft 5 inches tall and weighing 260 pounds stated he had received several verbal threats while at the County Jail about being assaulted while in the shower, being extorted for food items or pay rent. He has not had any threats while at CCCF, however, he did indicate he would not be able to defend himself and he has two "screwed up" rotator cuffs. He did state his case made the News and has been seen by other inmates.

This writer suggests he be placed on a MED supervision caseload despite his low ACRS until settle into his environment and engaged in a daily routine. Careful consideration should be given to his cell assignment.

Narrative: From the VRA by Mr. C. Mitchell dated 11/1/2010. While this inmate appeared to be accepted by other inmates, should he be housed in a penitentiary with higher custody inmates, it could affect his ability to safely serve his time. This inmate's response to questions about being sexually assaulted over a five year period of time, suggested some apprehension regarding serving time with numerous larger and more aggressive inmates. It is therefore, suggested this inmate may be at conditional risk to PREA concerns. His receiving facility's SART would benefit from observing his adjustment in order to rule-out this concern. Otherwise, the inmate appears to be at least moderate risk for being harmed, or more probably coerced. Russell(DOME) 11/3/2010

Narrative: From VRA by C. Mitchell dated 3/8/2009. Inmate's small body build; slight effeminate gestures/speech; "child sex" convictions as prominently displayed by several websites, as well as religious affiliation could make him the target of gang violence. These same risk factors and self-reported account of being raped inside a correctional institution (Westville Correction Facility, LaPorte County, Indiana) encourage recommending him to PREA risk concern. He is viewed being at least moderately high risk for being harmed by other inmates, or perhaps coerced/extorted. Interestingly, this inmate also suggested several times that he would not attempt to constrain knowledge of his homosexuality, and stating, "I'll not be a poser. I'm gay and don't care who knows it." Narrative: From VRA by C. Mitchell dated 11/01/2008. Inmate's youthful looks, lack of maturity and self-confidence, instant sex offenses, P-4 custody level and appearing naive, all suggest this inmate is at moderately high risk to being physically or even sexually coerced/assaulted. To his advantage, the inmate has reported no threatening behaviors and being able to get along with other inmates, in an adult offender population. Although the inmate's ability to avoid risk is tempered by months in segregated housing (jail only), his self-report, since arriving, suggests some adaptation already. Narrative: From VRA by C. Mitchell dated 5/6/2008. Inmate's body-language and demeanor belied an otherwise capable male. He expressed more fearfulness than most his age, which further suggests his young age, but extended conversation revealed more an inmate who had survived incarceration at a young age. Inmate appears to have adapted to incarceration through passive respect and default ingratiating. It is suggested he is at least of moderate risk to being harmed, but could be higher if he chooses to not assert himself. Maintaining psychiatric intervention and exercising more could also moderate his risk to being harmed. It is also suggested this inmate is at little risk to being sexually assaulted, but given he has no internalized boundaries against homosexual conduct, has a recent history of acting sexually inadequate, has six years incarceration to serve, and expected to regain his sexual interest, once adjusted, it is anticipated he may again become "curious."
